Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. W. D. Johnson and P. H. Harrell of this office during the period January 1-31, 1985, of activities authorized by NRC Operating Licenses DPR-51 and NPF-6 for Arkansas Nuclear One, Units 1 and 2, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. J. M. Levine, and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection included operational safety verification, maintenance, surveillance, 10 CFR Part 21 followup (Unit 1), 10 CFR Part 21 reportability review, LER followup, plant startup activities (Unit 1), preparation for refueling (Unit 2), and potential overpressurization review of the component cooling water system.

Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors. These findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities were in violation of NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to these violations, in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation enclosed with this letter.
