Florida Power Corporation (FPC) requests a schedular extension to the subject order for the submittal of the Detailed Control Room Design Review (DCRDR) Summary Report for the reasons outlined herein.

A Human Factors Audit Team from the NRC and supporting consultants performed an in-progress audit on the Crystal River Unit 3 control room design review from February 12, 1985 through February 14, 1985 as provided for in NUREG-0737, Supplement I, Section 5.2.a. It is anticipated that the Human Factors Audit Team will issue a report within 60 days. The FPC DCRDR Summary Report is presently scheduled for submittal on April 3, 1985 or about 40 days.

In order to include the Team's comments in the DCRDR Summary Report, we, therefore, request a schedular extension as suggested by the Audit Team for our DCRDR Summary Report submittal until 45 days after receipt of the Human Factors Audit Team Report. This will allow FPC to include the Team's comments which result in a more complete and comprehensive DCRDR Summary Report. Your approval of this delay is requested by March 15, 1985. Finally, the DCRDR Summary Report will not contain the final modifications and schedules for resolution of the human factor deficiencies. These modifications and schedules will be submitted on or before September 30, 1985.
