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

Response

Corrective Steps Which Have Been Taken and the Results Achieved

The six (6) procedures identified by the inspector were reviewed and the discrepancies concerning the use and accuracy of the LATERS pages are either corrected by Temporary Change Notices (TCN), or are being corrected by submittal of a procedure revision. Procedures GOP-0001, GOP-0002, GOP-0004, SOP-0031, and SOP-0032 were corrected by TCN Nos. 0-84-03, 0-84-04, 0-84-06, 0-84-02, and 0-84-01 respectively. Procedure ADM-0022 will be corrected by the submittal of a procedure revision.

Our review indicated that the procedures themselves correctly identified the LATER in the procedure body, and that the deficiency occurred because procedure preparers and reviewers did not assure the accuracy of the information included on the LATERS pages. All of the identified operating procedures (General Operating Procedures and Station Operating Procedures) have been approved; however, due to the status of the project, they had not been implemented. The LATER in the Station Administrative Procedure (ADM-0022) deals with a missing organization chart for the Operations Section.

On November 29, 1984, the station initiated a review of approved station procedures to determine the extent of this problem. Our review consisted of a 10% sample of those procedures written by each Plant Staff Section and our procedure preparation Contractor. The results of this sample review were generally satisfactory. However, the LATERS page deficiency rate in the following areas was unacceptable:

Fire Protection Procedures (FPP)

Operations Procedures (all types - GSU prepared)

Surveillance Test Procedures (STP) (contractor prepared)

Corrective Steps Which Have Been Taken and the Results Achieved (continued)

Based on the sample results, a review of 100% of approved procedures in the above areas is being conducted. Any LATERS page deficiencies will be corrected.

This Notice of Violation and the need to follow procedures were emphasized during Plant Manager staff meetings and procedure meetings, between the Plant Manager and the station supervisors.

Corrective Steps Which will be Taken to Avoid Further Violations

Review of the procedures in the three areas indicated on the preceding page will be completed and LATERS page deficiencies corrected. Those individuals responsible for the independent and technical review, and approval of procedures have been reminded by memorandum (APMS - 978-84) of their responsiblity to assure both the technical adequacy of procedures and compliance with Station Administrative Procedures. The need to comply with all written procedures will continue to be stressed by station management.

Date When Full Compliance Will be Achieved

Those procedures identified in the Inspection Report will be revised to be in compliance with ADM-0003 concerning the use of LATERS pages by January 31, 1985.

Additional reviews will be completed by January 31, 1985, and any resulting procedure revisions completed by March 3, 1985.
