However, if your safety review indicates no decrease in emergency preparedness, then changes can be made without NRC approval. In all cases, you should furnish copies of each change to the NRC in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q). Also any changes to the Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures should be made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, Section V (Implementing Procedures).
