Dear Mr. Reynolds:

This is to inform you that the Commission, by a vote of 4-1, with Commissioner Asselstine disapproving, has declined to review the Appeal Board decisions (ALABs-775/775A) in this docket. The time provided by NRC regulations within which the Commission may act to review has expired. Accordingly, the decisions became final agency action on February 26, 1985.

Commissioner Asselstine, in disapproving, stated that:

"I would take review. I think we ought to ask the Board to explain the bases for its decision in more detail. The decision as it now stands is a little short on explanation. Also, I don't think the Board should have considered the two types of character and competence evidence separately.' NUCLEAR REQU
