By letter dated October 24, 1984, Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) requested a license amendment concerning primary containment air locks. Upon subsequent review of this submittal, it was found that the words "air lock door" were inadvertently left out of Action a.1 of Technical Specification 3.6.1.3. The TS currently reads "... restore the inoperable air lock door interlock ..."; the correct wording is "... restore the inoperable air lock door/air lock door interlock ...". Enclosed is the corrected TS Page 3/4 6-4 for Brunswick 1 and Brunswick 2.
