Gentlemen:

This refers to the special security inspection conducted during the period August 20-24, 1984, of activities authorized by NRC Operating License DPR-40 for Fort Calhoun Station, and to the discussion of our findings with you and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection included selected portions of your physical security program and its implementation. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors. These findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities were in violation of NRC requirements. As a result of these findings, an Enforcement Conference was held in the Region IV office on October 11, 1984. As indicated in Appendix C, the findings of the inspection were discussed and your position on each was presented. Following this meeting, it was determined that escalated enforcement was appropriate, and our findings with regard to the matter will be transmitted to you separately. Therefore, no specific response to the violations discussed in this report are requested by this letter.

During this inspection, it was also found that certain of your activities appeared to deviate from commitments made to the NRC. These items and references to the commitments are identified in the enclosed Notice of Deviation (Appendix A). You are requested to respond to these deviations in writing. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Deviation enclosed with this letter.

Programmatic concerns not identified in the report as violations or deviations were referred to the NRC's Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation for further review.

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The material enclosed herewith contains Safeguards Information as defined by 10 CFR Part 73.21 and its disclosure to unauthorized individuals is prohibited by Section 147 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Therefore, the material, with the exception of the report cover page which is an inspection summary, will not be placed in the Public Document Room.

The response directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice is not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
