Dear Mr. Richardson:

The attached letter NSD-TAP-2092 contains information which is proprietary to Westinghouse Electric Corporation. Accordingly, we request that this information be withheld from public disclosure. This letter provides additional technical support for the Catawba Unit 1 IPC requested by the NRC staff on an expedited basis beyond that provided at the NRC meeting of August 28, 1992.

We will comply with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.790 to provide proprietary and non-proprietary versions of the above material together with an affidavit as soon as the proprietary and non-proprietary versions have been prepared. We will submit the total required number of copies of the proprietary and non-proprietary versions of the information and the required affidavit at that time.

In the meantime, we have provided a copy of this letter for your information and use. M. P. Siemien, Esq. of the NRC Office of the General Counsel, has advised Westinghouse that she concurs with this procedure.

We expect to be able to fully comply with the requirements for the proprietary and non-proprietary versions of the information and an accompanying affidavit by September 11, 1992.
