SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 030-05933/92-01

This refers to the routine, unannounced inspection conducted by Mr. Mark R. Shaffer of this office on August 25, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized by Byproduct Material License No. 35-11114-01. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with members of your staff.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under the license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of the license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews of personnel, independent measurements, and observation of activities in progress.

No violations or deviations were identified; therefore, no response to this letter is required.

The inspector observed that the licensee possessed ten radiographic exposure devices containing iridium-192 and three devices containing cobalt-60 to perform industrial radiography at temporary job sites throughout the state of Oklahoma. Licensed activities were also performed within a fixed radiographic exposure vault located at the licensee's permanent storage facility in Tulsa. The inspector noted that records of licensed activities were well maintained and adequate for the size and scope of the radiation safety program.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

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
