Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552, et seq., the National Whistleblower Center ("NWC") hereby requests a copy of any and all records and information ~~pertaining directly or indirectly to:~~

1) a Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") Office of Investigation ("OI") report believed to be entitled Alleged intentional Violations of Technical Specifications by a Vogtle Operations Manager, Case No. 2-90-001;

2) a November 1, 1991 special inspection team report relating to Plant Vogtle;

3) a January 11, 1992 report relating to Plant Vogtle; *spec. insp*

4) a January 2, 1992 \$100,000 fine issued to Georgia Power Company with respect to plant Vogtle.

This request includes but is not limited to transcripts, interviews, notes, letters, memoranda, engineering analyses, studies, data, interim and/or final reports, status reports, and any and all other records relevant to and/or generated in connection with the 1-4 above.

As you are aware, the FOIA requires you to release documents in segregable portions in the event they contain exempt material. For any documents or portions that you deny due to a specific FOIA exemption, please provide an index itemizing and describing the documents or portions of documents withheld.
