## Gentlemen:

This refers to the special safety inspection conducted by Dr. M. J. Oestmann of this office on December 11-12, 1984, of activities at the William H. Zimmer Nuclear Power Station, Unit 1, authorized by NRC Construction Permit No. CPPR-88 (Docket No. 50-358), Byproduct Materials License No. 34-07251-04, (Docket No. 30-11989) and Special Nuclear Materials License No. SNM-1823 (Docket No. 70-2838), and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. J. Schott and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection. Additional discussions have been held by telephone with Mr. G. Ficke of your staff on December 13, 14, 17, and 18, 1984.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your licenses as they relate to radiation safety and environmental protection and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your licenses. Within the areas examined, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

No items of noncompliance with NRC requirements were identified during the course of this inspection.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosure(s) will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1).
