Subject: Submittal of Revision 6 to the Fermi 2
Radiological Emergency Response Preparedness Plan

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(q), Detroit Edison hereby submits Revision 6 to the Radiological Emergency Response Preparedness Plan (RERP) for Fermi 2. This revision represents changes from a review of the entire plan. The changes include updating and correcting information; clarifying conditions and indications in Table D-1, "Clarification of Emergencies"; modifying the text to reflect NRC-approved Amendment 82 to the Technical Specifications issued June 9, 1992 relocating the radiological effluent Technical Specifications to the Offsite Dose Calculation Manual (ODCM); and removing the description of the Radiological Environmental Monitoring Program, referencing the ODCM.

Revision 6 to the RERP Plan has been reviewed in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q). The changes made in this revision are described in Enclosure 1, "Effectiveness Review Documentation," and do not decrease the effectiveness of the Plan. The Plan, including Revision 6 continues to meet the standards of 10 CFR 50.47(b) and the requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix E. Enclosure 2 is a copy of Revision 6 that includes revision bars to mark the changes.

This information is being submitted in accordance with 10 CFR 50.4(b)(5)(ii). In addition controlled copies of Revision 6 have been sent under separate cover to the NRC response centers as previously requested.


