Dear Congresswoman Boxer:

This is in response to your letter of August 2, 1991, requesting postponement of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards' (ACRS) review of the Long-Term Seismic Program for the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant on August 7 and 8, 1991 in Bethesda, Maryland.

The ACRS has advised me that they would defer its previously scheduled August 7 and 8 meetings and reschedule the Committee review of the Diablo Canyon seismic reevaluation. The ACRS Subcommittee on Extreme External Phenomena will hold a public meeting in San Luis Obispo County within several weeks to be followed by a full ACRS review in Bethesda, Maryland. The schedule for the meetings will be announced in the next few weeks. We will keep you informed on all matters pertaining to this issue.
