# Operator Licensing Program – Year in Review



- FY 19 RTR Exam Performance relatively consistent
  - Administered exams to 52 RO and 32 SRO candidates in FY18
  - **Written Exam Pass rate**
    - 42/52 for Reactor Operators (81%)
    - 13/14 for Senior Reactor Operators (93%)
  - **Operating Exam Pass Rate**
    - 48/52 for Reactor Operators (92%)
    - 31/32 for Senior Reactor Operators (97%)

# RTR Operator License Docket Summary

- 370 Active RTR Licenses
  - 179 Reactor Operators
  - 181 Senior Reactor Operators
  - 1 Limited Senior Reactor Operator
- 54% of active licenses have conditions
  - Most of these are corrective lens (82%)
  - Prescribed Medications (15%) Other (3.5%)

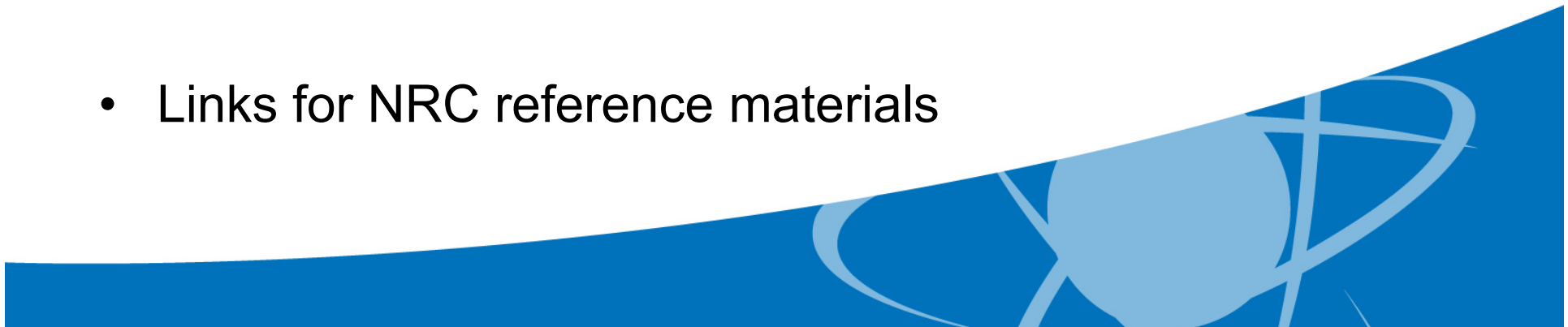
