We are pleased to confirm that Philadelphia Electric will reimburse bus operators, as well as other emergency workers, for incremental expenses incurred during and because of their participation in a Limerick plant-related emergency or drill, carried out in conformance with the radiological emergency response plans, upon receipt of a validated expense record itemizing the expenditures. Such reimbursement will not be duplicative of payments made by others, including governmental agencies, or that may be provided under existing law.
