

Withdrawal of Proposed Operating License
Change Request No. 187 (TAC No. 79621)

The purpose of this letter is to withdraw Proposed Operating License Change Request No. 187. This proposed change was submitted on February 7, 1991, as a follow-up to the Temporary Waiver of Compliance titled, "Containment Structural Integrity" issued by the NRC on January 25, 1991. Change Request No. 187 would have revised Surveillance Requirement 4.6.1.6.1 to permit, for a limited time period, an alternate surveillance requirement.

On June 23, 1992, the NRC issued Amendments 165 and 47 for Beaver Valley Units 1 and 2, respectively, as a result of Operating License Change Request No. 181 and 45. These amendments (165 and 47) removed the existing Surveillance Requirement 4.6.1.6.1 and permanently replaced them with a new surveillance requirement identical to the alternate surveillance requirement proposed under Change Request No. 187. Therefore, implementation of Change Request No. 187 is no longer necessary.
