This is to acknowledge receipt of Revision 13 of the Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant Emergency Plan via letter dated June 10, 1992. We have reviewed Revision 13 with the exception of additions to Section 4, Table 1 "Summary of Emergency Action Levels". Condition 18, ISFSI Events. The emergency action levels (EALs) relevant to the independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI) have been forwarded to our headquarters Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR) for their review. The results of NRR's review will be transmitted to you via a separate letter at a future date. From our review, we have determined that the remaining areas of Revision 13 do not decrease the effectiveness of your emergency planning for the Prairie Island Station.

The revision submitted included the following administrative and additional changes. The staffing goal of the Emergency Operations Facility was reduced from two to one hour to reflect the staffing of the facility by onsite personnel. The EALs defining a loss of any function needed for plant shutdown were revised to better define the inoperability of the residual heat removal system.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room.
