The Atomic Safety and Licensing Board has scheduled a hearing in the proceeding concerning issuance of an operating license for the Enrico Fermi Atomic Power Plant, Unit 2 under construction by Detroit Edison Company near Monroe, Michigan. The hearing will begin December 1, 1981. One of the three contentions to be litigated concerns evacuation of the Stony Pointe residential area on the shore of Lake Erie, near the Fermi-2 plant. A copy of the contention is attached for your information.

The NRC will provide witnesses to address the available evacuation routes and time estimates for evacuation, and appropriate protective actions. will be necessary for you to provide a FEMA witness to address the adequacy of local emergency notification systems and methods of evacuation of the Stony Pointe area over the Pointe Aux Peaux Road which parallels the plant site boundary. It is my understanding that the information concerning these matters has previously been provided to FEMA.

The Board issued an order on August 4, 1981 directing that pre-filed written testimony for this hearing be served by November 9, 1981. Therefore, I am asking for your assistance in arranging for a FEMA witness and written testimony on this narrow issue as soon as possible. I would very much appreciate having draft testimony on this matter in my hands by October 1, 1981.

For clarification, the following information is provided: A FEMA witness and written testimony is required for hearing concerning local emergency notification systems and means of

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evacuation of residents of the Stony Pointe area over the Pointe Aux Peaux Road.

Dates: Draft Testimony due: October 1, 1981

Prefiled testimony due: November 9, 1981

Hearing: December 1-4, 1981. (Place of

hearing not yet determined).

If you will, I would also appreciate notification of the FEMA member selected to testify at hearing on this limited matter at your earliest convenience. The person selected may contact the NRC Staff reviewer, Paul Psomas by telephone at 492-9688.
