
AEOD evaluated the LERs for Beaver Valley Unit 1. The enclosure contains the details of our evaluation for your consideration in assessing the licensee's performance.

Beaver Valley Unit 1

The LERs for this plant were evaluated for completion and accuracy for the period from December 1, 1981 through November 30, 1982.

The majority of the LERs reported during this period involved component failures. The description given on the LER form was sufficient in most cases and in the few cases where it was not, supplemental information was provided. When more information was promised, it was provided. The licensee was able to track repetitive events and institute changes in procedures, maintenance, or equipment when necessary. In general, the licensee attempts to correct root causes for recurrent events in a timely manner and does not hesitate to contact an equipment vendor if components are not performing as expected.

The licensee reported no component failure reports to NPRDS. Although this is not a reporting requirement, licensee participation is necessary to ensure a successful industry program.
