SUBJECT: THREE MILE ISLAND NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION, UNIT I (TMI-1)/POSSIBLE
FALSIFICATION OF REACTOR OPERATOR TRAINING RECORDS.

DATE CLOSED: May 31, 1983

This inquiry was initiated in order to interview THEODORE L. BOOK, a former TMI-1 Reactor Operations Shift Foreman, regarding his knowledge of the possible falsification of Reactor Operator training records at TMI-1. In a memorandum, dated June 17, 1977, from BOOK to "JIM" O'HANLON, the TMI-1 Plant Superintendent in 1977, BOOK discussed the inadequacy of Reactor Operator training and implied that the number of hours of training recorded in the Operator training records were not correct. A copy of the memorandum is appended as attachment (1).

On May 26, 1983, BOOK was interviewed at his place of employment, BABCOCK & WILCOX, Lynchburg, VA. In a sworn statement, appended as attachment (2), BOOK elaborated on the contents of his June 17, 1977 memorandum.
