In the reference letter, the Supply System was requested to follow up with the offsite officials on the planning issue that was identified in the subject report. The purpose of this letter is to provide you with an update on that planning issue.

The planning issue was identified as S92-01 (Incomplete procedures for use of dosimetry). FEMA's recommendation was to "Revise procedures to describe use of dosimetry and correct other missing information." According to Mr. Robert R. Mooney with the Washington State Office of Nuclear Safety, this planning issue should be resolved with the issuance of the revised procedure manual entitled "LABORATORY PROCEDURES FOR OPERATIONS DURING EMERGENCY RADIATION SITUATIONS", dated July, 1992, which has been accomplished. Based on our discussions with Mr. Mooney, we believe that the issuance of this revision resolves planning issue S92-01.

The Supply System is pleased that there were no deficiencies or areas requiring corrective actions (ARCAs) identified during FEMA's observations of the April 29, 1992 Washington State Laboratory drill.
