

The purpose of this letter is to request, under the Freedom of Information Act, all documents associated with NRC's new procedures for handling plant-specific backfits, as was directed in SECY-83-321 and Generic Letter 84-08. We are particularly interested in all issues which have been addressed according to NRC's new plant-specific backfitting plan and procedures.

Should any of these documents be exempt from production or disclosure, I request that all portions of the document, the disclosure of which "is not contrary to the public interest and will not adversely affect the rights of any person" be provided to us as is required by 10 CFR 9.9.

Since the subject information is being requested in support of a contractual effort (SANDIA Purchase Order No. 58-5707) being funded by the US Department of Energy, we request that all fees be waived under the provisions of 10 CFR 9.14(a)(2). Should this request charge all fees to International Energy Associates Limited's (IEAL) account, IEAL is willing to pay all appropriate and reasonable fees up to \$300.00.
