This refers to your letter dated June 27, 1988, in response to our letter dated May 27, 1988, concerning the alleged discrimination of an employee for having engaged in protected activities. A former employee alleged that he was improperly reassigned because he had raised safety concerns while performing his duties at the Enrico Fermi Nuclear Plant. After reviewing the information provided, we have concluded that there is insufficient evidence to substantiate his allegation. Therefore, we have determined that enforcement act is not appropriate in this case.

No response to this letter is required. In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
