This is in response to your letter dated April 17, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), a copy of the transcript of a meeting held March 26, 1984, on basemat adequacy at Waterford Unit 3, and any correspondence, memoranda, and/or working papers relating to that meeting.

The staff has identified the following records as being subject to your request.

1. April 6, 1984, meeting summary for LP&L's presentation of basemat adequacy at Waterford 3 by J. H. Wilson, with stated attachments. (This record has already been provided to you and other parties included on the service list.)
2. April 16, 1984, letter from R. S. Leddick to Harold Denton regarding construction adequacy of WSES-3 basemat. (This record has already been placed in the NRC's Public Document Room and the Local Public Document Room under accession number 8404190358, docket 50-382.)


As you know, on April 2 the staff undertook an intensive review to resolve issues in order to reach a licensing decision on Waterford Unit 3. Certain pertinent records are being provided to parties on the service list, as noted above. For your information, the staff intends to make relevant records not otherwise exempt under the FOIA publicly available following publication of a supplemental safety evaluation report. At that time, records related to basemat cracking will be placed in the docket file and separate file for a related FOIA request, FOIA-84-455, in both the Public Document Room and the Local Public Document Room.
