SUBJECT: TMI-1 LICENSING CONDITIONS TO BE IMPOSED PRIOR TO RESTART (OELD # 837 453)

I do not like the way in which the cover letter in this package is phrased. It makes it look like the staff is inventing something. It should be re-written to come across with - not that there requirements are in our opinion, things which must be imposed prior to the resumption of power operation; but rather that this is simply a package of conditions that should be incorporated into the license to reflect the Commission, Appeal Board and Licensing Board considerations. That's what I think it is intended to be. They're not separate staff-invented conditions. The cover letter should be changed so that it makes it very clear that this is a clerical role the staff is serving, not new staff ratchets.

You can send my note to Van Vliet as the basis for closing out the slip for our review of his proposed letter. I don't agree with his proposed letter and then you can tell him to come back and work with you at drafting a letter more along the lines of what I have in mind. It should be a letter which suggests that all we're doing is serving a clerical function.
