During an NRC inspection conducted on July 27-30, 1992, one deviation of a commitment made to the NRC was identified. In accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, the deviation is listed below:

- A. Rockwell International Letter, #90RC08723, which was submitted to the NRC Region V office on July 17, 1990, in response to a Notice of Violation issued in Region V Inspection Report 70-25/90-01, committed to issue the quarterly reviews of your radiation safety and environmental monitoring programs within a three month period.

Contrary to the above, as of July 30, 1992, the 1992 first quarter review had not been issued.

Please provide to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, DC 20555 with a copy to the Regional Administrator, Region V, in writing within 30 days of the date of this Notice, the reason for the deviation, the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved, the corrective steps that will be taken to avoid further deviations, and the date when your corrective action will be completed. Consideration may be given to extending the response time.
