The basis for the no significant hazards determination discusses only the fact that there is no increase in consequences of previously analyzed accidents. You need to identify and discuss at least briefly why this does not change the probability of an accident or result in any significant change in any safety maggin. All three are part of the example as well as the standards and you have to indicate why there is no significant effect on any of the three elements -- consequences, probability and margins.
