RECEIPT OF PETITION FOR DIRECTOR'S DECISION UNDER 10 CFR 2.206

Notice is hereby given that Mr. Robert Karalewitz (Petitioner) has submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on June 22, 1992, a Petition pursuant to 10 CFR 2.206.

The Petitioner requests that the license to operate the Fermi Nuclear Plant be suspended until certain supervisors are replaced. As a basis for this request, the Petitioner asserts that certain security department supervisors lied and falsified documents to the NRC. The Petitioner also asserts that these supervisors conspired to revoke his access to the protected area at Fermi-2 and to have him fired.

The request is being treated pursuant to 10 CFR 2.206 of the Commission's regulations. The Petition has been referred to the Director of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR). As provided by 10 CFR 2.206, the NRC will take appropriate action on this request within a reasonable time.
