Vern, you are using the example on a restriction on operation because acceptable operation has not been demonstrated. That is the wrong example to use for this situation. That is the situation that applies when a condition is put into the original initial operating license and we are getting rid of that. This was not a condition imposed on the original operating license for Vermont Yankee. So that is the wrong example to use, I don't think that there is a good example useful for this kind of a change. I think you have to go through each of the three criteria and explain why it fits each of the three criteria, that is, probability and the consequences of accidents, probability of a new accident or infringing on a safety margin.
