SUPPORT NRC STAFF REVIEW OF 2.206 PETITION (TAC NO. M84073)

The NRC staff is conducting its review of materials related to the 10 CFR 2.206 Petition filed by Michael D. Kohn on June 11, 1992, on behalf of the National Whistleblower Center and Messrs. Macktal and Hasan related to the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station (CPSSES). The staff has determined that additional documents are necessary to complete the review. You are requested to provide Exhibits L through Q, inclusive, to the January 30, 1990, settlement agreement between TU Electric and Tex-La Electric Cooperative of Texas, Inc. (Tex-La). You are also requested to provide copies of settlement agreements with all other former co-owners of CPSSES, and exhibits similar to those requested for TU Electric's January 30, 1990, settlement agreement with Tex-La.

The reporting requirements contained in this letter affect fewer than ten respondents, therefore OMB clearance is not required under Public Law 96-511.

You are requested to provide these documents within 20 days of receipt of this letter.
