SUBJECT: PROPRIETARY WITHHOLDING REQUESTS REGARDING THE BRUNSWICK STEAM  
ELECTRIC PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2

By letters dated September 6, 1990, February 11, 1991, April 26, 1991, and April 28, 1991, you provided information considered proprietary by General Electric Company (GE) for which withholding from public disclosure was requested under 10 CFR 2.790. It is the NRC's policy not to use an affidavit in response to 10 CFR 2.790 requests that are more than six to eight months old (up to one year in extenuating circumstances). The principal reason is that we do not know whether the information in the document is still considered proprietary.

As each of the affidavits you provided is over one year old, we request that you submit new GE affidavits for the documents in question to verify that the information is still considered by GE to be proprietary. The documents for which withholding was requested are listed below.

Letter of April 26, 1991, forwarded GE-NE-901-011-0391, "RWCU Differential Flow Leak Detection Analytic Limit Improvement," March '91 (NLS 91-110).

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
