SUBJECT: INTEGRATED DESIGN INSPECTION - SEABROOK.

A copy of the inspection report for the third Integrated Design Inspection performed for Seabrook Unit 1 is enclosed for your information and appropriate action. The results of the inspection and the conclusions reached by the inspection team are fully explained in the report. Section 1 of the report provides a summary of these results and conclusions.

In accordance with our usual practice, the report will be withheld from further distribution for a period of 10 to 25 days while the licensee reviews the report for proprietary information and, if appropriate, makes formal application for withholding any proprietary portions from public disclosure. The report will then generally be available and will be placed in the Public Document Room. The licensee will be requested to respond to the concerns identified in the report and we will review the responses for adequacy.

We recommend that NRR inform the Licensing Board of the issuance of the Seabrook IDI report. The most significant findings and concerns are identified in the cover letter and Section 1 of the integrated design inspection report.
