JACKSON, Mich., January 17, 1984 -- Consumers Power Company on January 12 received an order from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission which confirmed a previous agreement between the NRC and Consumers Power Company for an independent appraisal of the management of the Midland nuclear plant construction project.

The appraisal is the outgrowth of discussions between company management and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. Consumers Power Company is currently taking the necessary steps for this independent appraisal.

The NRC order closed the issue over whether the company had violated an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board order. The incident in question occurred in July 1982 and procedures to prevent its reoccurrence have been in place since August 1982. While the NRC concluded that we violated a board order, no civil penalty was imposed. We are pleased that this has been resolved.
