Dear Ms. Bell:

This is in further response to your letter dated June 1, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, the following:

- Budget sessions on mothballed nuclear power reactors;
- The status of the mothballed WPPSS Nuclear Project No. 1 reactor;
- The status of the mothballed WPPSS Nuclear Project No. 3 reactor;
- Preservation of equipment, structures, and components at mothballed nuclear plants; and
- 5. The need to file new application documents (FSAR, ER, etc.) at such time as the plant is "taken out of mothballs."

Appendix A is a list of additional documents related to your request. Document one is being placed in the PDR in the FOIA file folder. The remaining documents have previously been placed at the PDR. Access to these documents may be acquired by referencing the accession numbers listed by each document. Documents relating to this same subject were addressed and placed at the PDR in file folder 83-515.

The document listed on Appendix B is an internal draft memorandum containing the comments of the staff on the Maintenance and Surveillance Program Implementation Plan which is structured to describe the problem, identify the issues, outline the implementation strategy and the tasks to be accomplished, as well as schedule the major milestones resource requirements and critical internal and external interfaces, the results of which yet remain to be finalized. Release of this document would tend to inhibit

the open and frank exchange of ideas essential to the deliberative process. The document reflects the predecisional process and, therefore, is exempt from mandatory disclosure pursuant to Exemption (5) of the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(5)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(5) of the Commission's regulations. This document does not contain any reasonably segregable factual portions.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 9.9 of the Commission's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public interest. The persons responsible for this denial are the undersigned and Mr. Harold R. Denton, Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation.

This denial may be appealed to the Commission's Executive Director for Operations within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. As provided in 10 CFR 9.11, any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Executive Director for Operations, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision."

The staff is continuing to search for documents subject to your request. You will be notified when our search has been completed.
