Dear Ms. Garde:

This is in regard to your letter dated May 31, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), all records relevant to and/or generated in connection with all draft submittals of the supplemental safety evaluation report (SSER) by the task force for Waterford Unit 3. This is also in regard to your letter dated July 6 on the same subject.

On April 2, the staff undertook an intensive review, which is still in progress. Because the staff who are preparing the SSER are the same individuals who would have to search for records that are subject to your FOIA request, the NRC is not in a position to immediately respond to your request. Further, at this time, all drafts are predecisional. While we have been unable to date to determine the number of drafts that may be subject to your FOIA request, the staff intends to make the pertinent records not otherwise exempt under the FOIA publicly available at the NRC Public Document Room following publication of the SSER.
