As you are aware, NRR Office Letter No. 44 dated January 3, 1984, has implemented a new procedure for NRR Input into the SALP data base in which each organization contributing to the SER and/or SSER will also provide SALP input. The Shearon Harris-1 SALP period extends from 02/01/83 to 04/30/84. Since you have provided SER and/or SSER input, we request that you also provide SALP input by May 25, 1984.

SALP input includes an evaluation matrix where the applicant is to be rated Performance Category 1, 2 or 3 by each branch for each of the seven evaluation criteria. NRC Manual Chapter 0516 (enclosed) defines the categories and evaluation criteria. In most cases, some of the categories will be N/A.

In your response, please fill out the appropriate section of the attached matrix and provide a brief explanation for your rating for each evaluation criterion. This is most important if you rate the application as a 3.
