Enclosed is a letter from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) dated April 7, 1992, transmitting FEMA's final report for the March 4, 1992 exercise for the offsite portion of the Catawba Nuclear Power Plant.

During the exercise, one Deficiency was identified. This Deficiency was corrected during the March 4, 1992 exercise. Also, three Areas Requiring Corrective Actions (ARCAs) were identified. These ARCAs involved equipment and training of school bus drivers in Mecklenburg County and training of police officers in Cleveland County.

We encourage you to assist the appropriate counties in resolving the corrective actions identified by FEMA. Resolution of these items should be completed prior to the next full-scale emergency preparedness exercise.
