In reference to your letter dated March 1, 1979, we are enclosing the following requested information in order that you may expedite our license review.

1. Our authorization for Group IV therapy procedures listed Dr. Jack Dawkins, who is no longer with our hospital. Please delete therapeutic radio pharmaceuticals Group IV listed in Item 19.
2. Form NRC-313M-Supplement A: Since Dr. Pratap did not have 200 hours of training in basic radioisotope handling techniques, we would like to delete his name from the license at this time and apply on Dr. Jung Ja Hong. Please delete Dr. Pratap's name as Radiation Safety Officer. Dr. Hong is appointed as Radiation Safety Officer.
3. Instructions concerning how to reach the Radiation Safety Officer and her back-up designate have been amended on Item 16, page 2. This information is added to the memorandum to personnel who will receive radioisotope shipments during off-duty hours, as well as emergency procedures for spills, etc.
4. Our Medical Isotope Committee is composed of the required physicians. Enclosed are curriculum vitae on each of the committee members and the Medical Center Memorandum 114-1, dated March 7, 1979, which documents their membership. Dr. Jack Margolis, Chairman, Chief of Staff, is directly responsible to the Director.

We are submitting the above requested information so you may expedite this application review.

1. The Radiology Service of this VA Medical Center currently has two full time, fully qualified Radiologists; therefore, we are hereby submitting this application for By-Product and Material License (NRC Form 313M).

2. Medical District #25 and this VA Medical Center have identified a need for the Maxi-Camera II Scintillation Camera. The cost of this piece of equipment is over \$150,000.00. Overriding the initial expenditure is the urgent need to increase our nuclear medicine capabilities. A need, both current and projected, is evident for this facility to be able to perform nuclear medicine services.

3. Presently we are having to procure radioisotope tests on a fee basis. The fee basis for these studies has increased both in cost factor and number of studies required. Transportation is also a costly factor that should be considered.

4. I would greatly appreciate your assistance in approving funds for the equipment and in processing this license application.

5. I respectfully request that this application be expedited whenever it is feasible to do so.
