This deadly waste cannot be stored safely anywhere, so we will most likely be a permanent regional dump. NO! The D.O.E. has stated they will not be liable for these wastes if an interim site is not built by 1998, a date the Government Accounting Office states is unlikely. Therefore I ask for:

- 1. full democratic process in the crucial decision.
- 1. full public hearings held in the sited area.
- I. an environmental impact statement filed with the EPA and the State of Michigan.
- a. a full cost/benefit analysis be done examing the cost of nuclear power and examine other sources of energy.
