Linda E. Mitchell. By letter dated September 4, 1992, you ged the Commission to stay final action on the Director's Decision and to consider the testimony presented in a Department of Labor proceeding, excerpts of which you provided in your letter. NRC regulations provide that, within 25 days after the date of the Director's Decision, the Commission may on its own motion review that decision, in whole or in part, to determine if the director has abused his discretion. Review is at the discretion of the Commission; no individual has the right to such a review. No petition or other request for Commission review of a Director's D ision under this section will be entertained by the Commission (See 10 CFR 2.206(c)). Therefore, in accordance with 10 CFR 2.206(c)(2) your request is denied. The Commission has determined not to undertake a formal review of the Director's Decision in this matter. Accordingly, the decision became final agency action on September 8, 1992.
