Nebraska Public Power District is submitting a supplement to the  
referenced letter in accordance with a request made by  
Mr. J. B. Baird, USNRC - Region IV. The purpose is to expand and  
clarify items No. 1 and 2 of the referenced letter.

Clarification of item 1 includes moving the Emergency Exercise anni-  
versary date from March to October of each year. It is understood  
that, if the anniversary date is moved to October, Nebraska Public  
Power District will continue to exercise its Emergency Preparedness  
Program on this schedule.

Nebraska Public Power District will conduct communications, off-site  
monitoring, and other appropriate tabletop drills to ensure maintenance  
of the current Emergency Preparedness Program. Certain drills are to  
include activating portions of the Control Room, Technical Support  
Center, and Emergency Operations Facility and will be conducted prior  
to Cooper Nuclear Station returning to commercial operation.


