WATERFORD PROCEEDING

On January 7, 1985, Applicant Louisiana Power and Light Co. filed a response to your December 1984 affidavits in the Waterford proceeding. A copy of the Applicant's response is attached.

The Applicant's response consists of a legal reply prepared by LP&L's attorneys -- which interprets various statements contained in your affidavits -- along with the affidavits of Joseph Ehasz (EBASCO), Professor Myle Holley (MIT), Kenneth Cook (LP&L), and Raymond Burski (LP&L).

In particular, please inform me if LP&L has misinterpreted your affidavits in any manner, or if LP&L's affidavits present statements which are untrue or inconsistent with sound engineering principles.
