Thank you for your response of August 15, 1984 to our Notice of Violation issued on July 17, 1984 concerning licensed activities conducted at your Crystal River facility. We have evaluated your response and found that it meets the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201.

We have carefully reviewed the bases for your denial of the stated violation. We would have expected that, if the flow gauge had been installed on the flow line, the FPC representative who accompanied our inspector would have noted to our inspector that the gauge was in the line. Subsequent to our receipt of your response, the NRC resident inspector verified that the gauge was installed on the subject line and the flow calibrations had been conducted on the same gauge prior to our inspection of June 20, 1984. Based on these findings we withdraw the violation and have deleted it as a violation from our records. We agree with your described actions for correcting problems related to the control of breathing air and will examine them during future inspections.

We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
