## SUMMARY

Scope:

This routine, unannounced inspection was conducted in the area of Physical Security Program for Power Reactors. Specific areas inspected were: Management Support; Security Program Plans; Audit; Protected Area Barriers, Detection Aids and Assessment Aids; Protected Area Access Control - Packages, Personnel and Vehicles; Alarm Stations; Communications; and Security Training and Qualifications.

## Results:

In the areas inspected, violations or deviation, were not identified.

Violation No. 92-08-02 was closed. The licensee continues to provide appropriate security measures to protect vital resources. Plant management from Security Shift Supervisor up was involved and providing necessary support to the security program. Noteworthy was the support St. Lucie Nuclear Plant Security provided Turkey Point Nuclear Plant during the post Hurricane Andrew operations. The licensee's Security Training Program and Personnel Access Program were found to be effective and more than adequate.

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
