SUBJECT: ELECTRICAL CABLE SEPARATION MEETING SUMMARY

A meeting was held on August 30, 1984 at the Beaver Valley Unit 2 site to discuss electrical cable separation and the Regulatory Guide 1.75 (Revision 2) Implementation Plan. The attendees included representatives from the applicant, Stone and Webster Engineering Corporation, the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation and Region I. A list of attendees and meeting agenda are included as Enclosures 1 and 2, respectively. The meeting included a plant tour which enabled the staff to observe the progress of cable separation at BVPS-2. The meeting is summarized as follows:

- The applicant reported that cable pulling is presently about 50% complete. When cable pulling has reached 80% completion, the NRC power systems audit will be conducted. This is anticipated to be October, 1985.
- 2. Included in the overview of the electrical separation and the applicant's Regulatory Guide 1.75 (Revision 2) Implementation Program was a discussion of the training program and electrical separation tracking system.
- Duquesne Light Company described the use of a silicon dioxide cable wrapping (Siltemp) which is applied longitudinally.
- 4. Three of the approximate 14 testing configurations were described. An informational copy of the testing plan will be submitted to the staff by mid-September, 1984. The final testing plan will be transmitted formally by the end of September, 1984. The final testing plan and all configurations will be presented to the staff at a meeting scheduled for the end of September, 1984, in Bethesda, Maryland.
- 5. The configurations to which the applicant will test are planned to be more conservative than those to be actually installed. Both will be submitted to the staff by the end of September, 1984. The design used in actual installation will be included in the FSAR.

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- 6. All portions of Draft Safety Evaluation Report (DSER) Open Item 197 were not addressed at the July 19, 1984 power systems electrical meeting. Clarification to DSER Sections 8.3.3.3.4 through 8.3.3.3.6 were therefore given at this meeting.
- Documentation of the information presented at the meeting, including slides, will be submitted by mid-September, 1984.

The applicant's presentation was successful in satisfying the intent of the meeting, which was to provide the staff with information concerning the details and status of cable separation at BVPS-2. Further staff response to this issue will be given through review of the applicant's formal submittals, and plant inspections to be conducted by Regional personnel.
