SUBJECT: ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGES TO PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY
OF NEW HAMPSHIRE IN THE SEABROOK FSAR

We have reviewed the proposed quality assurance related changes to the Seabrook FSAR, which primarily pertains to establishing a new division (New Hampshire Yankee Division) within the Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH). This new division within PSNH has the delegated authority and responsibility for the design and construction of the Seabrook project. As a result of this review, we conclude that the changes are generally acceptable and that the QA program continues to be in accordance with 10 CFR 50 Appendix B. However, to confirm our preliminary finding, we request the following additional information.

1. Describe in more detail the interface responsibility between the quality assurance organization of Yankee Atomic Electric Company (YAEC) construction department and the organizational units within the following: 1) New Hampshire Yankee Division (NHYP), 2) United Engineers and Constructors (UE&C) and 3) Westinghouse Electric Corporation (WRD).
2. Identify the organizational positions within the NHYP and YAEC with stop work authority and describe the extent this authority is documented and transmitted to personnel within PSNH, YAEC, UE&C and WRD.
3. Since Mr. Brown and Mr. McDonald are on the YAEC payroll, describe any authority and responsibilities they might have outside the Seabrook project and identify the approximate percentage of time devoted to this outside activity.
4. Describe those provisions for resolving disputes involving quality arising from a difference of opinion between QA/QC personnel and other department personnel within PSNH, YAEC, UE&C and WRD.
