Thank you for your letter dated September 15, 1992, in response to our July 17, 1992 letter which forwarded concerns regarding motor operated valves and maintenance personnel being inhibited from talking to the Quality Verification group at the Clinton Power Station (AMS No. RIII-92-A-0053). We requested that the specific items listed in the July 17 letter, as a minimum, be addressed and that the results of your review and disposition of the matter be submitted to Region III.

Your response indicated that your investigation of the matter did not substantiate the forwarded concerns. We are continuing to investigate this matter and request that you retain the supporting documentation for your investigation for a minimum of 1 year from the date of this letter.
