Thank you for your response of August 20, 1984, to our Notice of Violation issued on July 20, 1984, concerning activities conducted at your Browns Ferry facility. Based on the conversation between Mr. J. Coffey and Mr. F. Cantrell during the enforcement conference in Region II on September 26, 1984, it is our understanding that TVA was not denying violation I.D. (2) and a revised response clarifying the TVA position will be forthcoming. We have evaluated your response and found that it meets the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201. We will examine the implementation of your corrective actions during future inspections.
