This refers to the special inspection conducted by Messrs. I. T. Yin and J. A. Lennartz of this office on September 14-18, 1992. The inspection included a review of authorized activities for your Callaway Nuclear Plant facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with Mr. G. Randolph and others of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report documents our evaluation of your investigation of essential service water (ESW) and residual heat removal (RHR) water hammer events, including related documentation, root cause assessment and corrective actions. We determined that your staff had taken appropriate short term corrective actions for the water hammer events reviewed. Your long term corrective actions to mitigate the effects of a water hammer event in the ESW system coincident with a loss of offsite power and safety injection will be reviewed by the NRC.

No violations of NRC requiremer's were identified during the course of this inspection.
