Dear Ms. Doroshow:

This is in regard to your letter dated April 22, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 14 categories of records regarding the Three Mile Island Nuclear Plants (TMI) and/or General Public Utilities. In your request, you stated that the requested documents will be used for public education purposes. This confirms the information conveyed during the telephone conversation between you and Linda Robinson on July 20, 1984.

In reviewing your request, the staff noted that with the exception of category n, on which there is a hearing, all categories of your request have been part of the TMI-1 restart proceeding which began in 1979.

Both prior to and subsequent to NRC's receipt of your FOIA request, the NRC has made voluminous amounts of records pertaining to TMI generally, as well as particular matters covered by various categories of your request, publicly available through various means. The NRC has routinely placed pertinent records in the appropriate docket files in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR) for public inspection and copying. The PDR records include certain major documents made publicly available some time ago, such as the volumes of the Special Inquiry Group's report (Rogovin Report) on the accident at TMI and NUREG-0600 "Investigation into the March 28, 1979, Three Mile Island Accident by Office of Inspection and Enforcement" which reference several thousand related documents. More recently, the NRC has made available through the PDR the volumes of NUREG-1020 and NUREG-1020-LC "GPU v. B&W Lawsuit Review and its Effect on TMI-1" which reference documents related to that lawsuit, and other pertinent records such as the numerous exhibits and pertinent investigative reports numbers H-83-002, 1-83-010, 1-84-005, 1-83-012, 1-83-013, 1-83-028, Q-1-84-004, and Q-1-84-006, as well as related Chairman Palladino's correspondence to the Mayor of Lancaster which is maintained under PDR accession number 8406050015.

The NRC has placed pertinent records in FOIA files in the PDR in response to other FOIA requests on TMI. We are enclosing a listing of the FOIA requests received from January 1979 through June 1984, to which NRC has responded or is processing for response, which identifies the various pertinent subjects

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addressed in those requests. In particular, please note FOIA-84-148 which covers records related to category n of your request. In addition, you may wish to inspect PDR folder FOIA-84-166 covering other records regarding the Sholly amendment.


A computer printout identifying all PDR records pertaining to TMI may be obtained from the PDR in the event you are interested in such a printout.

As a party to the restart proceeding, since the date you submitted your request you have received copies of numerous records related to the various categories of your request, including Board Notification 84-121 which disseminated NUREG-1020-LD and copies of the exhibits and investigative reports identified above. Background investigatory records related to those investigations were not, of course, made publicly available. Also, certain other investigatory records have not been disclosed to date, such as records related to leak rate falsification which are subject to a pending Commission decision with regard to whether NRC will conduct further investigations in regard to that matter. More recently, parties to the restart proceeding have received the supplemental safety evaluation report (NUREG-0680 "TMI-1 Restart, an Evaluation of the Licensee's Management Integrity as it Affects Restart of Three Mile Island Nuclear Station Unit 1 Docket 50-289"). This NUREG report addresses records on which the staff relied in its evaluation of management integrity issues, which are basically the exhibits to various investigative reports noted above.

In light of the fact that NRC has already made pertinent records publicly available at the PDR and disclosed pertinent records to you and other parties in the TMI-1 restart proceeding since the date you submitted your request, we are asking that you now review records that have already been made publicly available and then redefine and clarify the scope of your request, which as it stands is a broad, sweeping, indiscriminate request for production which lacks reasonable specificity. Please request records with such specificity as that reflected in your August 3, 1984, discovery request on the remanded matter in the restart proceeding, which covers records related to category h of your FOIA request. That August 3 request is also being considered as clarification of the scope of category h of your FOIA request.

- c). allegations by TMI-2 clean up workers Richard Parks, Larry King, Ed Gischel, Joyce Wenger, and William Pensyl.


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- d). the "Keaton" drafts (i.e., GPUSC's Task Force Investigation into the Unit 2 accident).

- g). possible false statements made by either GPU President Dieckamp or GPU Board Chairman Kuhns during GPU's November 28, 1983 presentation to the Commission.
- h). Herman Dieckamp's May 9, 1979 mailgram to the Hon. Morris K. Udall.
- i). the BETA and RHR reports, including whether such reports were improperly withheld from the Commission.
- j). the "Hartman" allegations, (i.e., Unit 2 leak rate falsification).
- k). whether financial considerations have an improper impact on technical decisions.
- l). management changes and/or reorganization of personnel.
- m). the Commission's overall handling to the management "integrity" issues, including directives to OI on how to prioritize and proceed with its investigations.

If all or any part of this request is denied, please cite the specific exemption(s) which you think justifies your refusal to release the information and inform us of the appeal procedures available to us under law.
